

## ***Admission Requirements***

- Toddler Program: 14 months on or before September 1<sup>st</sup>  
Must be walking independently  
Must be able to feed self a snack and lunch
- 2- Year Old Program: 2 years old on or before September 1<sup>st</sup>  
Must be walking independently  
Must be able to feed self a snack and lunch
- 3-Year Old Program: 3 years old on or before September 1<sup>st</sup>  
Must be able to feed self a snack and lunch  
Must be totally toilet trained, pull-ups are not permitted  
Should be able to use the bathroom facilities with limited adult help  
Must be able to communicate their needs to a teacher by talking and using hand motions  
Should be able to follow simple teacher's directions for activities
- 4-Year-Old Program: 4 years old on or before September 1<sup>st</sup>  
Must be able to feed self a snack and lunch  
Must be totally toilet trained, pull-ups are not allowed.  
Should be able to use the bathroom facilities with limited adult help  
Children should be able to communicate their needs in an understandable manner  
Children should be able to work cooperatively in small groups and in large group activities

No exceptions are made to the age requirements.

## **Required Paperwork**

A copy of your child's birth certificate must be provided.

Each child in preschool is required by Georgia Law to have a valid immunization form on file. Children must meet state standards for immunization. You will need a Georgia Certificate of Immunization form #3231 as proof of immunization. To claim a medical exemption, parents must provide a letter from the child's pediatrician stating that the child is medically unable to be immunized and/or being immunized would create a health problem. The Archdiocese of Atlanta does not accept a religious exemption.
